Glaciers worldwide are melting at an accelerating rate due to rising global temperatures, primarily caused by human activities and greenhouse gas emissions

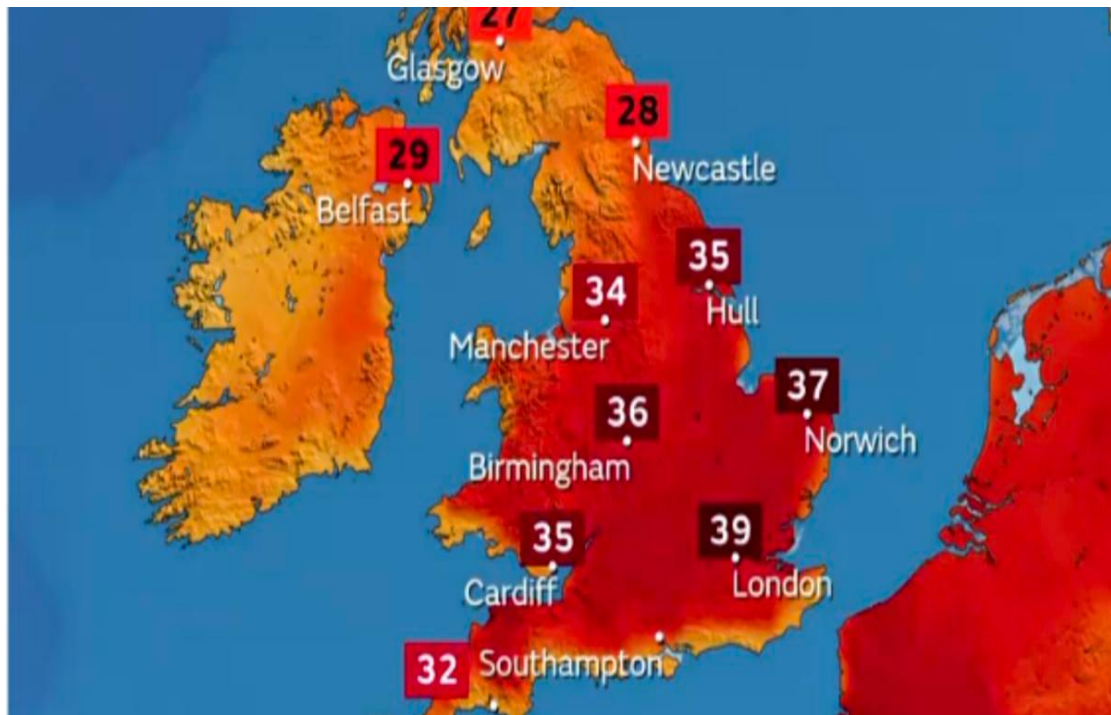

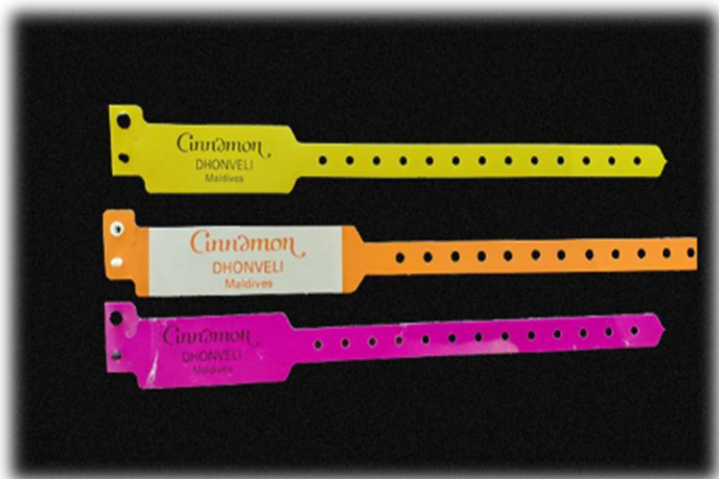

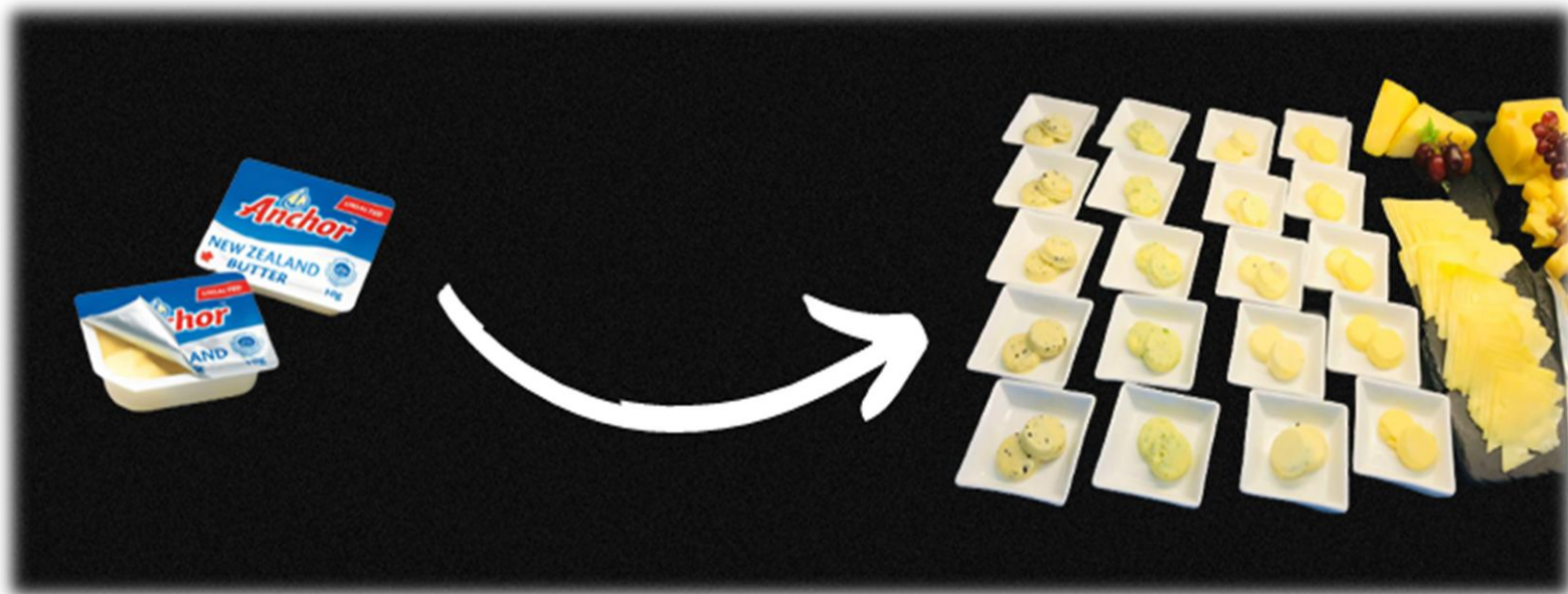
